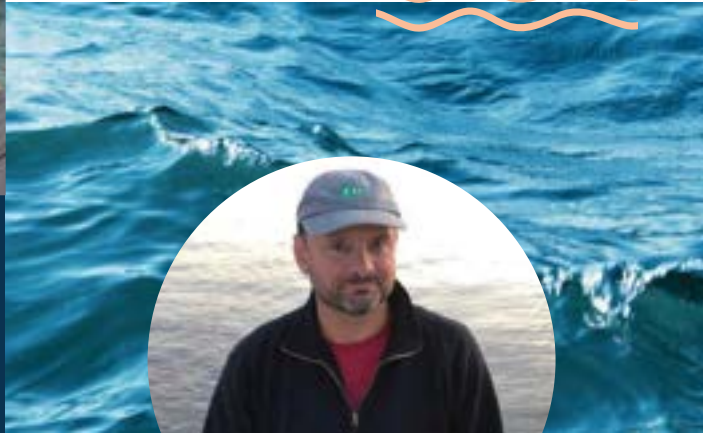


WELCOME TO OUR 2024 CRUISING SEASON

Sat, July 13 – Sun, July 14

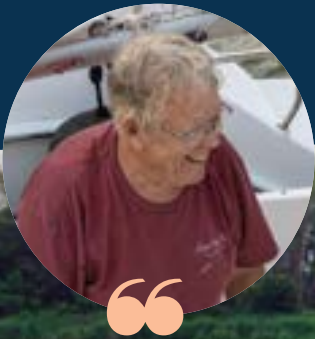
